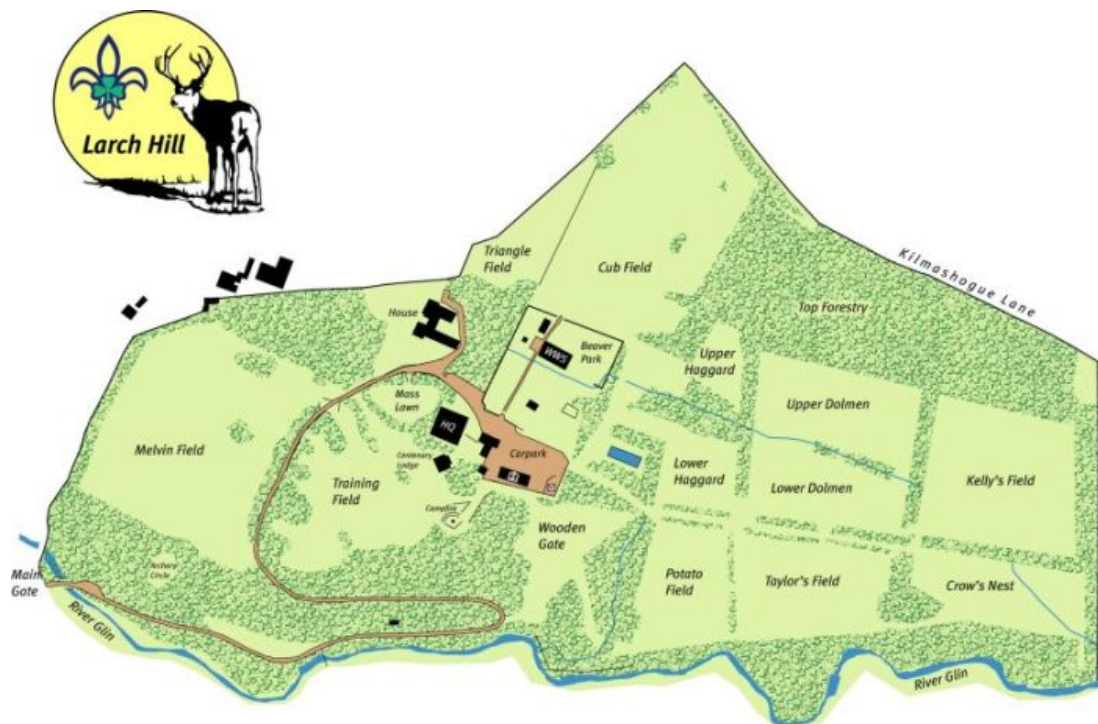

- Fires are only permitted in certain areas, areas where scouts will be staying, but we will not be camping in these particular fields. Firewood is supplied for the fire circle.
- Quite time 11.30pm to 7.00 am
- Toilets and showers for campers beside the car park. These are also in the accommodation buildings.
- GOOD NEIGHBORS'
- Due to difficulties created by trespassing on neighboring lands you are requested to contact Campsite Reception when planning hikes in the area. The Meitheal or Centre Manager will indicate to you the Private Lands surrounding Larch Hill which should be avoided.
- On no account should these lands be trespassed upon. To do so could lead to prosecution by the Land Owner.
- Particular attention is drawn to the lands on Kilmashogue Mountain.
- Hikers wishing to cross Tibbradden Mountain to Pine Forest should go via Tibbradden Lane and then by the state forest trails.
- A Hike Route must be completed and submitted to Campsite Reception before you leave the campsite.
